

## REALTORS® Political Action Committee Shared Funds Request Form



ORPAC Bylaws and ORPAC Policies and Procedures require that shared funds be used strictly for local candidates. **"Candidate contributions can only be made for county, city, district education, and special service district offices."** (ORPAC Policies and Procedures, III., B.)

Realtor® Association's interviewing of, and support or opposition of, candidates for public office must be limited to the Association's territorial jurisdiction as assigned and approved by the Board of Directors of the National Association of Realtors®. Where municipalities and/or public political office overlap two or more Realtor® Associations' territorial jurisdictions, the Associations must make every effort to coordinate candidate interviews, positions of support or opposition, or endorsement.

Shared funds are available from January 1 of each odd-numbered year through August 31 of the following even-numbered year. The request deadline is the Tuesday before the general election of the even year.

This form **must be signed and initialed** by the AE (EO) or local president as confirmation of approval by directors of the local board or association. The check will be made out to the candidate's campaign.
