

HOME FOUNDATION AWARDS \$196,000+ FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING

SALEM, OR – The OAR HOME Foundation awarded \$196,480 to 32 community nonprofit organizations dedicated to affordable housing throughout the state of Oregon. This brings the total of grants awarded to over \$1.5 million since the program’s inception in 2004.

The HOME Foundation is a 501C3 nonprofit corporation providing financial resources to create, expand, and encourage homeownership opportunities for Oregonians at or below local median income. Money raised comes directly from member REALTORS®, industry affiliates and event fundraisers. Local REALTOR® Associations will present the funds awarded to the grant recipient organizations in their area in the coming weeks.
